










SORTING GUIDE FOR HOUSEHOLDS IN ANEBY MUNICIPALITY

	Examples of waste	Do <u>not</u> throw	Where it should be thrown	Remember...
Waste thrown in the refuse bin	Food waste  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Food waste, cooked or raw • Fruits, vegetables, peelings • Coffee grounds, coffee filters, tea grounds, tea bags • Shellfish waste, eggshells, meat • Bread, cookies, biscuits • Cooking oil • Withered flowers 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Soil, clay, sand, gravel • Chewing gums • Cigarette ends, snuff • Diapers, sanitary protections • Ice lolly sticks • Potted plants - Throw in residual waste. 	Throw food waste in green plastic bags in the refuse bin.	The plastic bags must be knotted. Make the knot as tight as possible to ensure that no insects can crawl in.

Throw residual waste in red plastic bags (or plastic bags of other colors, except for green) in the refuse bin.	The plastic bags must be knotted.
Waste thrown in the recycling center or collected by the refuse lorry	Hazardous waste  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Perfume, acetone, nail polish • Electrical devices, watches, batteries • Paint • Engine oil • Spray cans that are not empty • Light bulbs, fluorescent tubes 	Medicine and syringes -Must be taken to a pharmacy.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you live in a detached or semi-detached house: Place the waste in the red recycling box. • If you live in a flat: Ask your landlord where to throw hazardous waste. • Leave at the recycling center. 	Hazardous waste should be thrown in its original packaging or another sealed packaging with a label of its content. Hazardous waste must be separated.
	Bulky waste  <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Electrical waste: appliances, TVs, power tools, car batteries, electrical appliances • Combustible waste: Furniture, rugs, sleds • Scrap metal: hobby and gardening tools, bicycles, kitchen utensils, cutlery, lawnmowers (emptied of oil) • Non-recyclable waste: porcelain, ceramics, WC seats 	Construction waste -Must be taken to the recycling center.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you live in a detached or semi-detached house: Pick-up can be ordered two times per year. Order pick-up at amaq.se or 0380-46 370. • If you live in a flat: Ask your landlord where to throw the bulky waste. • Leave at the recycling center. 	When you have ordered pick-up, bulky waste must be placed in sacks with a maximum of 15 kg. The sacks must be labeled with the contents, such as <i>electrical waste, combustible, scrap metal, or non-recyclable</i> . Max 2 m³ per pick-up.

Waste thrown at a recycling station	Example: Cartons, cardboard, paper bags, milk packagings, wrapping paper. 	Example: plastic jars, plastic pockets, plastic cans, styrofoam, plastic bags, plastic tube, plastic film, empty plastic spray bottles. 	Example: Glass packaging and glass jars without cans. No drinking glasses or porcelain. 	Example: Tin cans, aluminum foil, caps, cans, metal tubes, empty metal spray bottles. 	Example: Flyers, sheet paper, newspaper, catalogs, paperbacks.

The recycling center at Kretsloppsgården

Most kinds of waste can be thrown at the recycling center in Kretsloppsgården, such as bulky waste, gardening waste, electrical waste, hazardous waste, packaging, newspapers, etc. The waste is sorted into 20 different fractions and is recycled or taken care of in different ways. Gardening waste can be left 24/7 next to the entrance of the recycling center.

Leave packaging at recycling stations

All types of packaging should be thrown in a recycling station. This applies to paper packaging, plastic packaging, plastic packaging, metal packaging, newspaper, and waste paper.

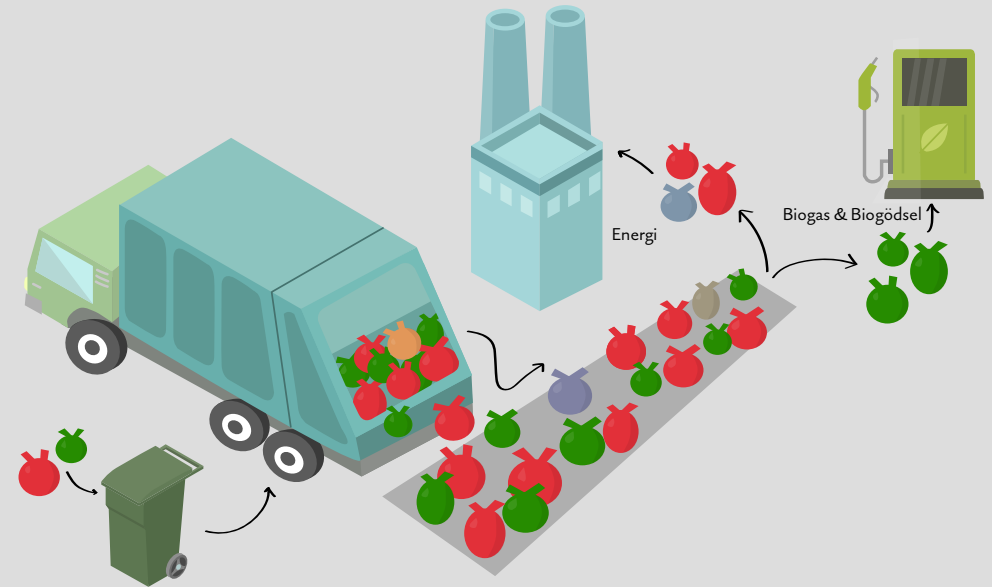

How does optical sorting work?



When sorting your household waste, food waste should be thrown in the green plastic bags and residual waste in the red plastic bags (or other colors, except for green). When the bags are filled, you knot them and throw them in the refuse bin. The refuse lorry collects your waste and drives it to an optical sorting facility, where the bags are sorted automatically with a camera technique that recognizes the color of the bags. The green bags, with food waste, are being rotted in a biogas facility and transformed into biogas and biofertilizer. The other-colored bags, with residual waste, are being burned in a CHP plant and transformed into district heating and electricity.

Remember this when sorting your waste

- All waste in the refuse bins must be placed in plastic bags. Make sure to knot the bags as tight as possible to ensure so no waste falls out.
- The green bags must only contain food waste. Other kinds of waste in the green bags can cause problems in the rot facility, which may lead to poison going into the biofertilizer and the nature.
- The day the waste is being picked up: Place the refuse bin max two meters from the road and place the side with wheels and handles towards the road. Make sure to keep the path to and around the refuse bin free from snow and slippery.
